Rev. Kaz Nakata is currently a Resident Buddhist Minister at Los Angeles Homba Hongwanji Buddhist Temple, a Ph.D. student in Buddhist Studies at University of the West, and an on-call Hospital Chaplain at USC Cancer Center. He received an ordination at Hongwanji Temple in Kyoto Japan, Pastoral Counseling training at University of Maryland, and Pastoral Incident Command System Training at the Federal Emergency Management Agency. He is a member of American Academy of Religion, as a Buddhist Scholar. His areas of expertise are original Buddhist Texts in Sanskrit, Pali, Tibetan, and Chinese, although his main research area is the Pure land Buddhist teachings in South and East Asia. He has lectured or spoke on Buddhism at UCLA, George Mason University, American University, George Town University, the Rayburn House Office in D.C. the White House, etc. He provides the youth ministerial training at his resident temple. He was a first US Buddhist County Chaplain at the Department of the Emergency Management of the Fairfax County, Virginia. Also he is a first Buddhist Priest, conducted Quinceañera, the coming of age ceremony.
